



Tips on Self Storage

These are a few basic DOs and DON'Ts for using Self Storage that our customers have found helpful.

- ➔ DO NOT store anything that cannot be replaced (antiques, family photos, family heirlooms, etc.)
- ➔ DO NOT store anything that a change in temperature and humidity will damage. Condensation may form on the ceilings. Please cover your contents to protect them.
- ➔ DO make sure you are insured. We will not be responsible for any losses.
- ➔ DO place dust covers over furniture for protection.
- ➔ DO set out mouse poison. If you have your things in storage for several months, set off a bug fogger a few days before you plan to move out to kill bugs and spiders.
- ➔ DO check inside your storage unit regularly. We check doors and locks daily.
- ➔ DO call us if you lose your key or break the key off in the lock. Please do not attempt to remove the lock yourself.
- ➔ DO pay your rent on time. The unit will be locked and your code number deactivated if your rent is past due.
